SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**Appointment of Alternate
Person to Perform Election Duties**

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama will hold a Special Municipal Election for the qualified electors of the City to decide whether they are in favor of an elected school board; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Selma has certain duties to perform in conducting a Municipal Election under the laws and statutes of the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, George P. Evans, Mayor of the City of Selma, while serving as President of the Selma City Council may have taken action or made statements or remarks during his term as president to influence the outcome of the special election; and

WHEREAS, to avoid any appearance of impropriety, the Mayor desires the Selma City Council to appoint a disinterested individual to perform his election duties; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has the authority under the laws and statutes of the State of Alabama to designate a disinterested individual to perform said election duties.




