

# RESOLUTION

## R250-06/07

**WHEREAS** the City of Selma invited and accepted bids during the month of August 21, 2007 through August 28, 2007 on a bid proposal on a Multifunction Digital Copier for the Police Department (PD-Copier-2007). Further detailed specifications were given in the Bid (PD-2007); and

**WHEREAS** the City Clerk has complied with Sections 41-16-50 through 41-16-63 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, by advertising the bid in City Hall and further by notice to selective vendors; and

**WHEREAS** the City Clerk opened the sealed bids on August 28, 2007 and Ray Davis & Company was the lowest responsible bidder.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the City Clerk is hereby ordered to forward a signed copy of said resolution to Ray Davis & Company, notifying the same of the City of Selma's acceptance and approval of the bid and is hereby awarded the contract of the Multifunction Digital Copier in the amount of Three Hundred Eight-Two Dollars and Ninety-Five Cents (\$382.95), for Sixty (60) Months Fair Market Value.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor, James Perkins, Jr., in his official capacity as Mayor, is hereby directed to proceed with the execution of the contract awarded to Ray Davis & Company.

SECTION 3. The City further authorizes the payment of the lease amount to be paid from Equipment-Non-Fixed Assets (1.6100.530-4).


