

# RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the City of Selma invited and accepted bids during the month of August 22, 2007 through September 6, 2007 on a bid proposal on the Police Department Uniforms (PD-Uniforms-2007). Further detailed specifications were given in the Bid (PD-Uniforms-2007); and

WHEREAS the City Clerk has complied with Sections 41-16-50 through 41-16-63 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, and has given notice thereof by advertising the bid in City Hall and further by notice to selective vendors; and

WHEREAS the City Clerk opened the sealed bids on September 6, 2007 and McCain Uniform Company was the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: That the City Clerk is hereby ordered to forward a signed copy of said resolution to McCain Uniform Company, notifying the same of the City of Selma's acceptance and approval of the bid and is hereby awarded the contract of the Police Department Uniforms in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-One and No/100 Dollars (\$1,231.00) per complete unit for a Policeman, School Crossing Guard and Jailer.



SECTION 3. The City further authorizes the payment to be paid from Clothing and Uniforms (1.6100.203-0).


