

**RESOLUTION
R258 - 06/07**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has the management and control of the finances of the City of Selma per State Law; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk opened the sealed bids on August 31, 2007 and Moore-Stewart was the only responsible bidder; and


WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept a lease agreement for the purchase of eight (8) police patrol vehicles for a cost of \$247,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama desires to amend the budget using funds from the *Police Department's Unused Salaries* (1.6100.103.0) and transferring to the Police Department's Lease Purchase Equipment line item (1.6100.430.91) for the initial lease payment due September 28, 2007 of \$55,000.00 for eight (8) police patrol vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA, that **FIFTY FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$55,000.00)** is hereby transferred from the Police Department's Unused Salaries (1.6100.103.0) to the Police Department's Lease Purchase Equipment line item (1.6100.430.91) for the initial lease payment due September 28, 2007 of \$55,000.00 for eight (8) police patrol vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA, that Mayor James Perkins, Jr., as the City's official representative, be authorized to enter into lease agreement with Ford Motor Credit Company said police patrol vehicles.


